

Rules

All General Livestock Rules also apply to this show.

- A. This show is open to both Cloverbud and regular 4-H members. Coverbud members in grades K-3 may only participate in the Cloverbud Exhibition. The Cloverbud exhibition is a non competitive showmanship class. The Clovebud member may show only one goat.
- B. All animals that are shown must be a 4-H project this year and be recorded in a project book. This is not a sanctioned show
- A. Entry fees are \$1.50 per animal and showmanship classes are due Tuesday, July 20, 2021, to the show secretary. Entries received after July 20, 2021 will be \$3.00 per class.
- B. Salem County Goat Herders, Salem County Fair Association, or the Salem County 4-H cannot be held responsible for loss, damage accident or illness to any person, animal or property at the fairgrounds. All animals entered at the owner's risk.
- C. Goats must be free from foot rot, sore mouth, ringworm, or any other infectious or contagious diseases. Any animal showing abscesses, open sores or general poor health will not be permitted on the grounds. Goat must have a USDA flock Identification Tag or Tattoo. Health papers must be present and completed by a veterinarian. *
- D. Goats must be checked in by 5:15 PM the day of show. Check in time begins at 4:45 PM. Judging will begin at 5:30 PM.
- E. Sorry, there are no pens available. Bring your own hay, buckets and leads.
- F. Members are required to do their own fitting and handling at the show.
- G. White shirt and pants are required to show all goats.
- H. This show is for doe Alpine, Nubian, Saanens, LaMancha, Recorded Grades, Toggenburg, Oberhasli, Unrecorded Grades, Nigerian Dwarf, Pygmy ,Boer,Myotonic. There will be a class for any other breed of goat, if there are 5 or more registered, which are certified. All wethers will be shown in meat goat class.
- I. The original registration or recordation certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older. For animals under 6 months of age, the original registration or recordation certificate or a duplicate application stamped by the ADGA or certifying goat association is required.
- J. Animals that do not have registration or recordation certificates or duplicate stamped applications will be show in the unrecorded grade class.
- K. No bucks of any age are permitted at show or on the fairgrounds.
- L. No horned animals will be permitted to show or stay at the fair.

M.Age of animal should be computed to as of the day of the show.

* Please note that if you are showing in the state show the veterinarian must assess your goat on your property.

- 6. Dry Yearling ,12-24 months*
- 7. Milkers ,Under 2 years*
- 8. Senior Milkers 2-4 years*
- 9. Senior Milkers, 4 years and older*
- 10. Meat Goat & Wethers, over 3 months but under 6 months \star
- 11. Meat Goat & Wethers, over 6 months but under 12 months \star
- 12. Meat Goat & Wethers, over 12 months \star
- 13. Fiber Goats over 3 moths but under 6 months $\mathbb C$
- 14 Fiber Goats over 6 months but under 12 months \mathbb{C}
- 15 Fiber Goats over 12 months \mathbb{C}

* Cloverbud members grade k-3, may only to participate in the Cloverbud Exhibition. It is a non-competitive, showmanship class. Only one goat may be used. 4-H members will be available to assist the Cloverbud member in handling the goat as needed.
