Rules

All General Livestock Rules also apply to this show.

- This show is open to both Cloverbud and regular 4-H members. Cloverbud members in grades K-3 (as of Sept. 2021) may only participate in the Cloverbud Exhibition. The Cloverbud exhibition is a non competitive showmanship class. The Cloverbud member may show only one goat.
 - All animals that are shown must be a 4-H project this year and be recorded in a project book. This is not a sanctioned show
 - Entry fees are \$1.50 per animal and showmanship classes are due Tuesday, July 26, 2022, to the show secretary. Entries received after July 26, 2022 will be \$3.00 per class.
 - Salem County 4-H Goat Herders, Salem County Fair Association, or the Salem County 4-H cannot be held responsible for loss, damage, accident or illness to any person, animal or property at the fairgrounds. All animals entered at the owner's risk.
 - Goats must be free from foot rot, sore mouth, ringworm, or any other infectious or contagious diseases. Any animal showing abscess, open sores or general poor health will not be permitted on the grounds. Goats must have a USDA flock Identification Tag or Tattoo, or national goat association tattoo. Health papers must be present and completed by a veterinarian. *
 - Goats must be checked in by 5:15 PM the day of show. Check in time begins at 4:45 PM. Judging will begin at 5:30 PM.
 - Sorry, there are no pens available. Bring your own hay, buckets and leads.
 - Members are required to do their own fitting and handling at the show and on fairgrounds.
 - White shirt and white pants or white jeans are required to show all dairy goat breeds. Those showing meat goat breeds only and or market goat may wear black pants or black jeans with a white sleeved shirt.
 - This show is for: Alpine, Nubian, Saanens, LaMancha, Recorded Grades, Toggenburg, Oberhasli, Unrecorded Grades, Nigerian Dwarf, Pygmy, Boer, Myotonic. There will be a class for any other breed of goat, if there are 5 or more registered, which are registered with certifying goat association.
 - There will be a wether class for dairy breeds of goat, separate from meat goat breeds. Market goats are considered goats under 12 months of age that will be sold for meat.
 - The original registration or recordation certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older. For animals under 6 months of age, the original registration or recordation certificate or a duplicate application stamped by the ADGA or certifying goat association is required.

Animals that do not have registration or recordation certificates or duplicate stamped applications will be shown in the unrecorded grade class.

- No bucks of any age are permitted at show or on the fairgrounds.
- No horned animals will be permitted to stay on the fairgrounds. Boer goats are the only horned breed allowed to be shown in the invitational goat show.
- Age of animal should be computed as of the day of the show.

*** Please note that if you are showing in the state show the veterinarian must assess your goat on your property.**
